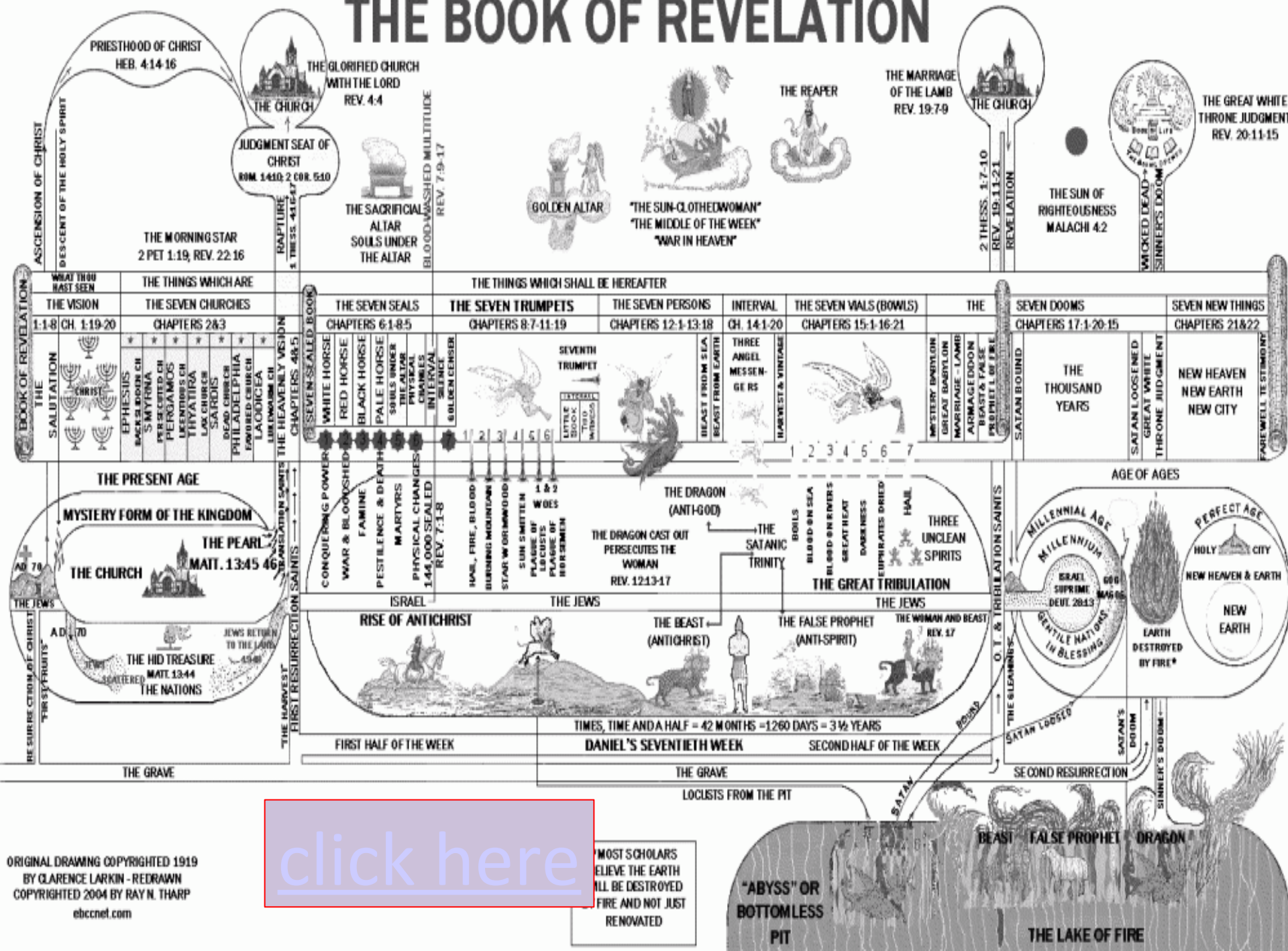

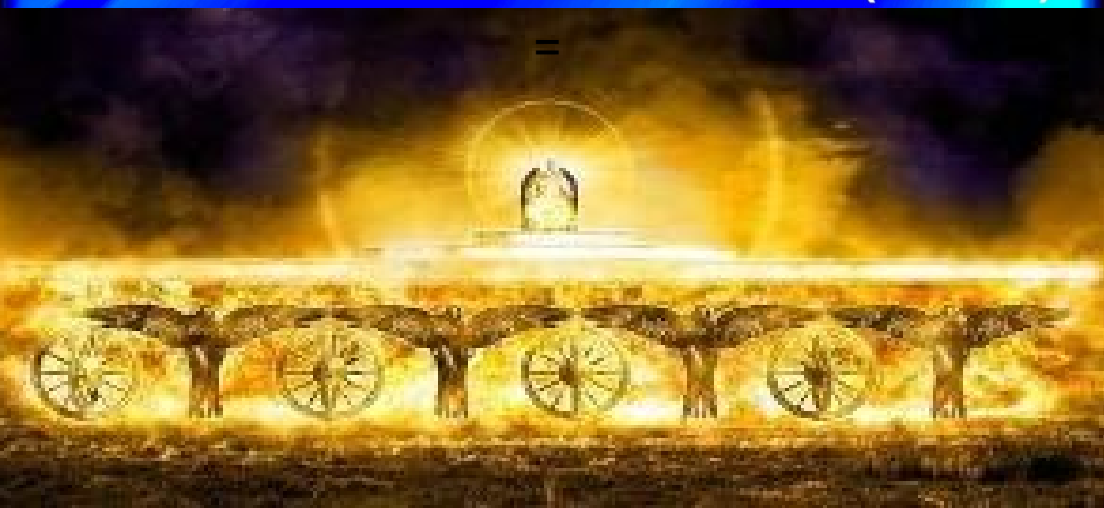

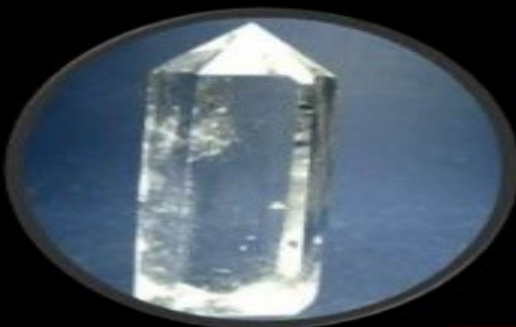

# The prophecy of Isaiah 11 speaks of Jesus and the seven Spirits of God:

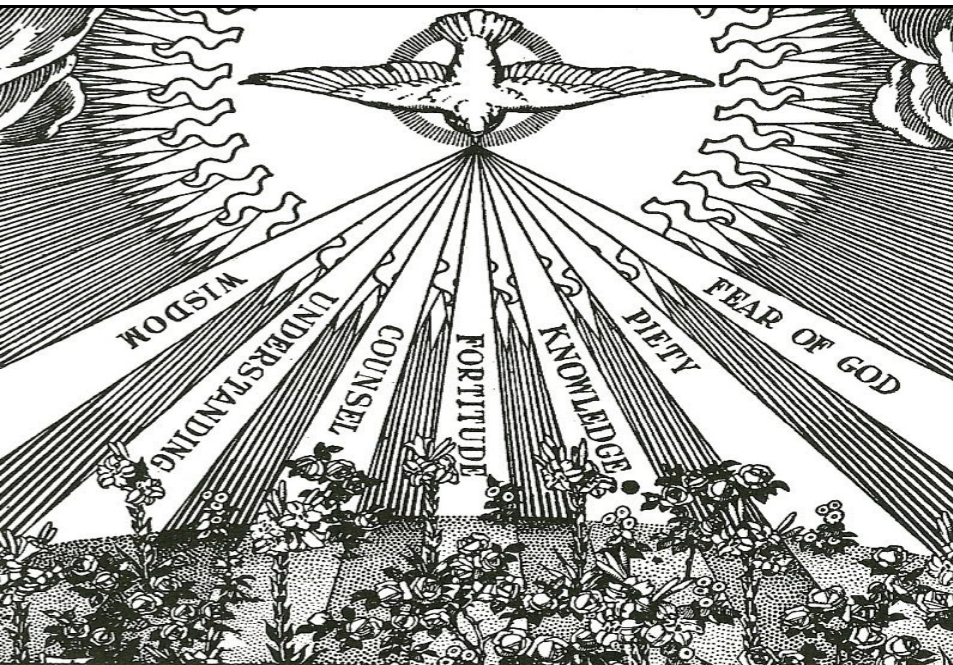
«There shall come forth

(ISAIAH 11:1,2)

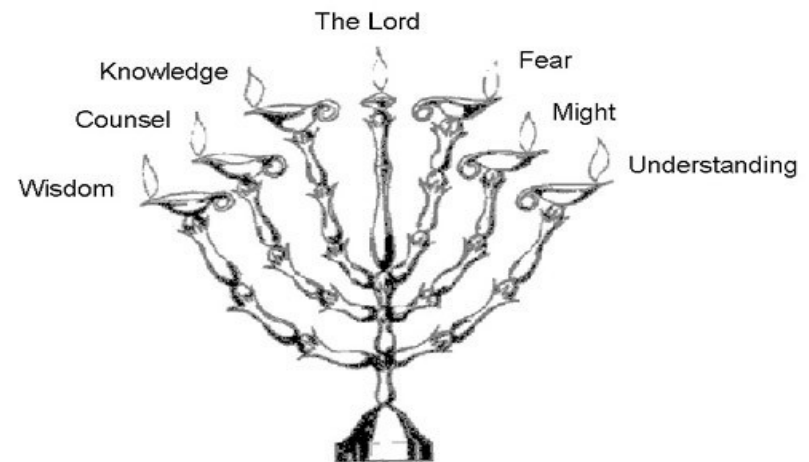
