

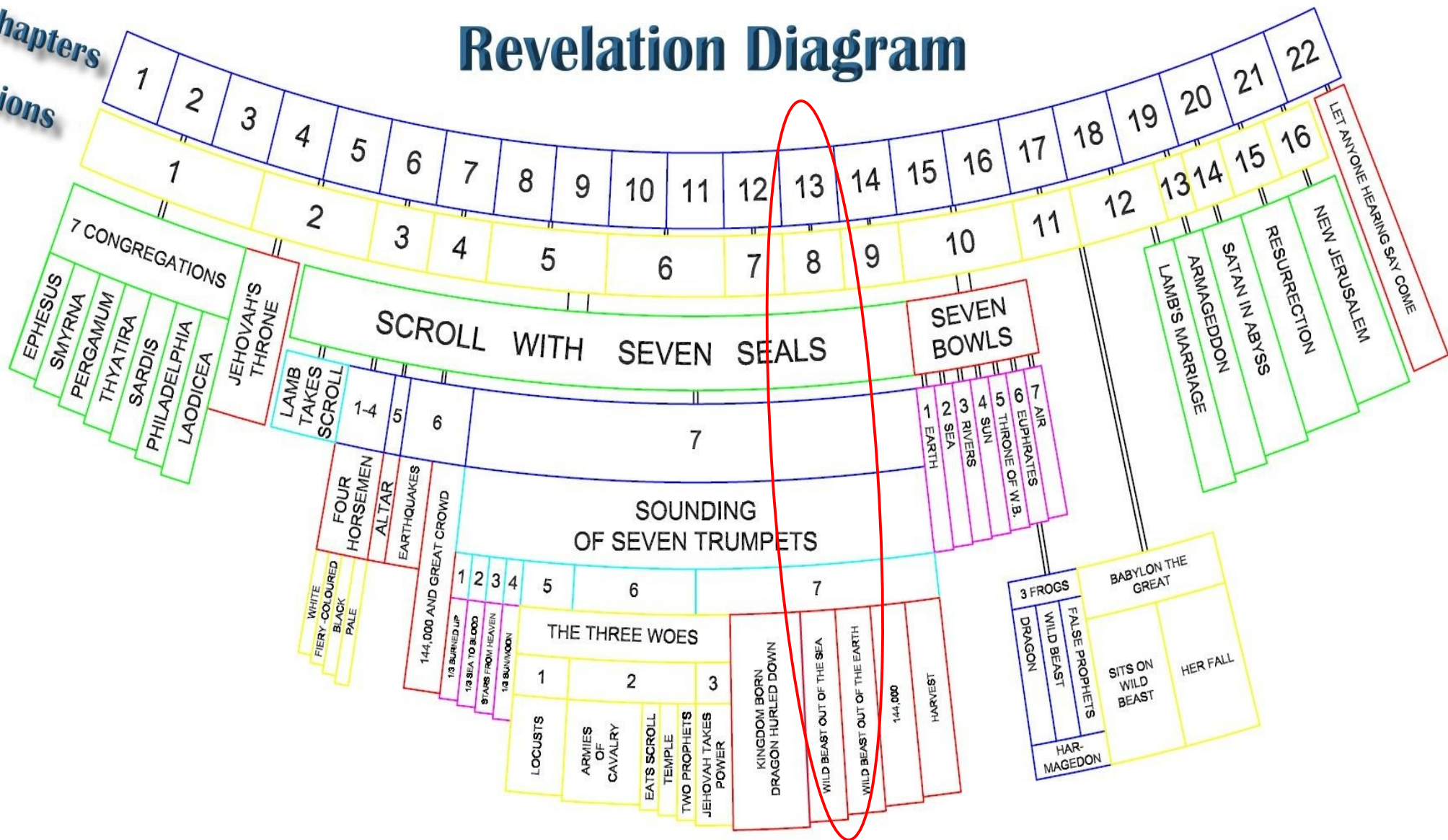

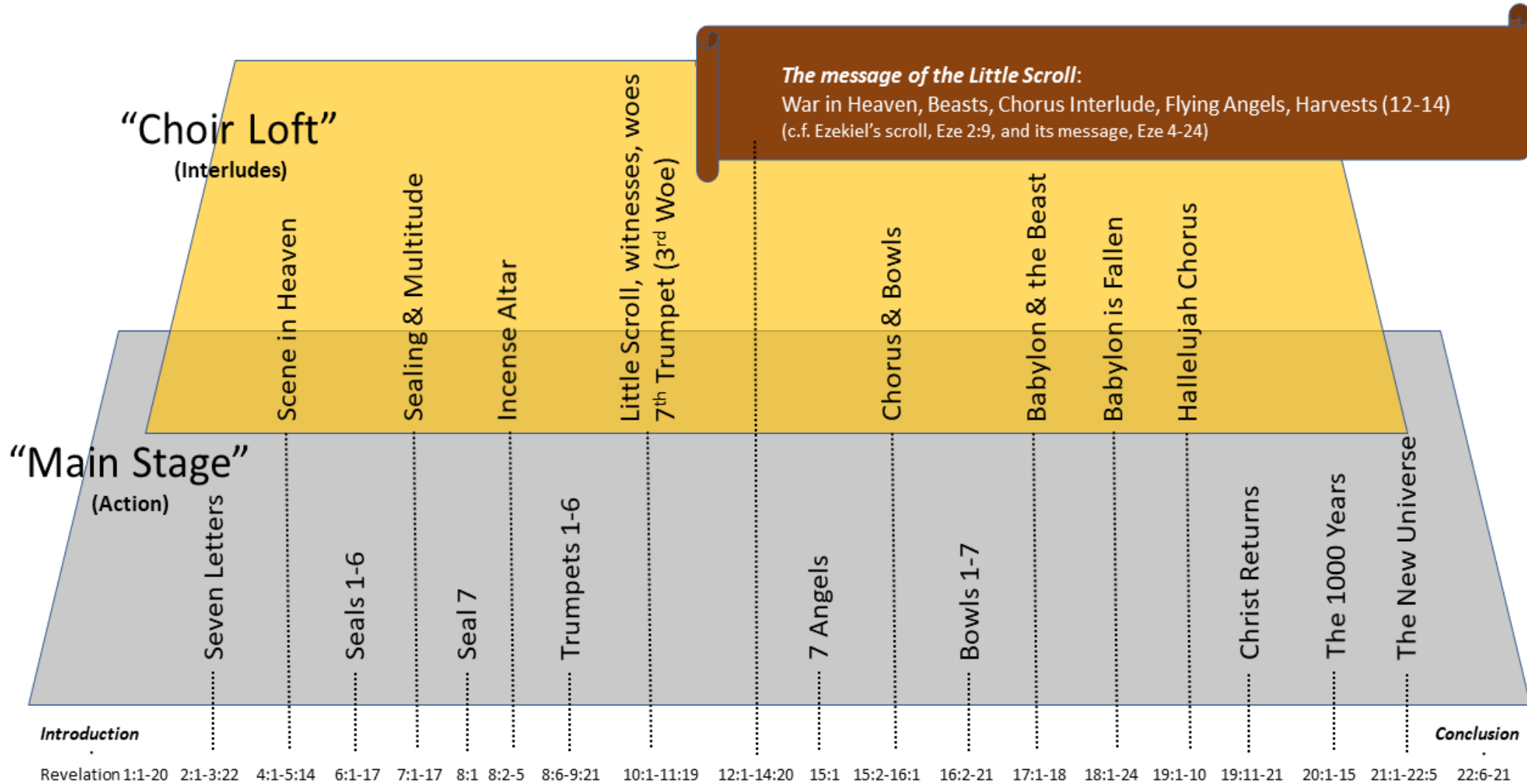

# *The Dramatic Structure & Outline of Revelation*



## *The Beast out of the Sea*

- 1 Then I saw a beast rising up out of the sea. It had seven heads and ten horns, with ten crowns on its horns. And written on each head were names that blasphemed God.
- 2 This beast looked like a leopard, but it had the feet of a bear and the mouth of a lion! And the dragon gave the beast his own power and throne and great authority.
- 3 ¶ I saw that one of the heads of the beast seemed wounded beyond recovery—but the fatal wound was healed! The whole world marveled at this miracle and gave allegiance to the beast.





4 They worshiped the dragon for giving the beast such power, and they also worshiped the beast. “Who is as great as the beast?” they exclaimed. “Who is able to fight against him?”

5 ¶ Then the beast was allowed to speak great blasphemies against God. And he was given authority to do whatever he wanted for forty-two months.

6 And he spoke terrible words of blasphemy against God, slander-  
ing his name and his dwelling—that is, those who dwell in heaven.

7 And the beast was allowed to wage war against God’s holy people and to conquer them. And he was given authority to rule over every tribe and people and language and nation.



8 And all the people who belong to this world worshiped the beast. They are the ones whose names were not written in the Book of Life before the world was made—the Book that belongs to the Lamb who was slaughtered. <sup>[fn]</sup>

9 Anyone with ears to hear should listen and understand.

10 Anyone who is destined for prison will be taken to prison.

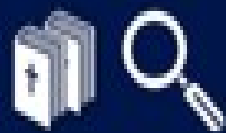
Anyone destined to die by the sword will die by the sword. This means that God's holy people must endure persecution patiently and remain faithful.





## *The Beast out of the Earth*

- 11 ¶ Then I saw another beast come up out of the earth. He had two horns like those of a lamb, but he spoke with the voice of a dragon.
- 12 He exercised all the authority of the first beast. And he required all the earth and its people to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound had been healed.
- 13 He did astounding miracles, even making fire flash down to earth from the sky while everyone was watching.



14 And with all the miracles he was allowed to perform on behalf of the first beast, he deceived all the people who belong to this world. He ordered the people to make a great statue of the first beast, who was fatally wounded and then came back to life.

15 He was then permitted to give life to this statue so that it could speak. Then the statue of the beast commanded that anyone refusing to worship it must die.

16 ¶ He required everyone—small and great, rich and poor, free and slave—to be given a mark on the right hand or on the forehead.

17 And no one could buy or sell anything without that mark, which was either the name of the beast or the number representing his name.

18 Wisdom is needed here. Let the one with understanding solve the meaning of the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man.<sup>[fn]</sup> His number is 666.<sup>[fn]</sup>

# SEVEN WORLD EMPIRES

**EGYPT (c. 2100 B.C. to c. 1400 B.C.)**  
A son of Ham was the first king of Egypt. When Joseph went to Egypt, foreign "Shepherd Kings" may have been in control. The Hamites were back in power at the time of the Exodus.

**ASSYRIA (c. 1100 B.C. to 606 B.C.)**  
The ancient city of Nineveh finally rose to power over her rival Babylon. The Assyrians ruled the world with force and fear, and demanded great sums of tribute money.

**BABYLON (606 B.C. to 538 B.C.)**  
Babylon was even older than Nineveh. Daniel lived in this great, impregnable city and saw it fall to the Medes and Persians. —Dan. 2:37, 38; 7:4; & Daniel 5.

**MEDO-PERSIA (538 B.C. to 333 B.C.)**  
Cyrus the Great freed the Jews to return and rebuild the Temple. About 454 B.C. Artaxerxes let them rebuild Jerusalem. Dan. 9:25

**GREECE (333 B.C. to 146 B.C.)**  
Alexander the Great conquered the world in only 10 years! The Greek culture and language later greatly helped spread the Gospel. Dan. 2:39; 7:6; 8:5-8

**ROME (44 B.C. to 455 A.D.)**  
By the time Jesus was born, Augustus Caesar ruled the world with almost complete control. This period of world peace allowed the message of Jesus to go into all the world more easily.

**TODAY**  
The feet are today, a mixture of nations: clay democracies and iron dictatorships. Dan. 2:41-43

**ANTI-CHRIST**  
The toes are the time of the final 10 kings of the Anti-Christ. —The most terrible time in the history of the creation, but also the greatest finish with the return of Jesus Christ to rule the Earth with His saints for the next thousand years. Dan. 2:44, 45

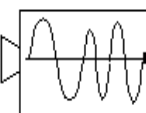


**FREQUENCY MODULATOR, VOICE CONTROLS FREQ.**

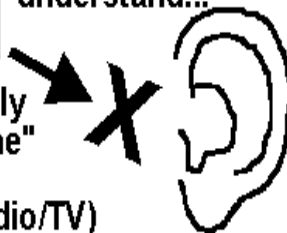

False prophet

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False prophet occurs in 4 verses in the KJV

Acts 13:6

And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a **false prophet**, a Jew, whose name [was] Barjesus:

Revelation 16:13

And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs [come] out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the **false prophet**.

Revelation 19:20

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False prophets

## Gematria

- The substitution of numbers for letters of the Hebrew alphabet, was a known method of exegesis that could be used to "calculate" a value from a word (or name).
- The number of the beast (a man) is given as **"chi xi stigma"** in the Greek language. It proper denotes 600 and 60 and 6. Together, we have a sum of 666. Revelation 13:17 and 15:2 associate the number of the beast with the **"number of his name"**.



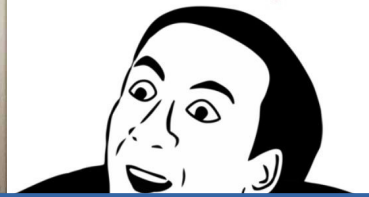
18 ¶ Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number *is* Six hundred threescore *and* six.

This surviving text (Papyrus 115) dates to the third century, c. 225-275 AD and include Revelation 2:1-3, 13-15, 27-29; 3:10-12; 5:8-9; 6:5-6; 8:3-8, 11-13; 9:1-5, 7-16, 18-21; 10:1-4, 8-11; 11:1-5, 8-15, 18-19; 12:1-5, 8-10, 12-17; **13:1-3, 6-16, 18**; 14:1-3, 5-7, 10-11, 14-15, 18-20; 15:1, 4-



An interesting element is that it gives the number of the beast in Revelation **13:18** as **616** (chi, iota, stigma (ΧΙϚ)), rather than the majority reading of **666** (chi, xi, stigma (ΧΞϚ)), as does Codex Ephraemi Rescriptus.

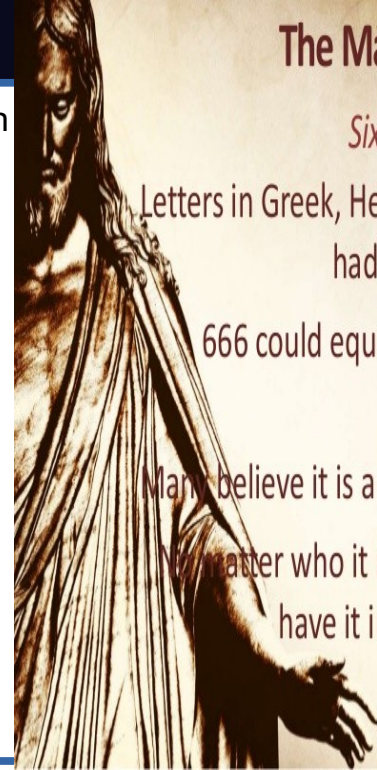
## The Mark of the Beast

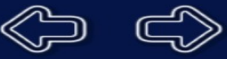

13 ¶ ‘I was looking in the visions <sup>[fn]</sup>in my mind *as I lay* on my bed, and behold, an *angelic* watcher, a holy one, descended from heaven.

14 ‘He shouted out and spoke as follows: “Chop down the tree and cut off its branches,  
Strip off its foliage and scatter its fruit;  
Let the beasts flee from under it  
And the birds from its branches.

15 “Yet leave the stump <sup>[fn]</sup>with its roots in the ground,  
But with a band of iron and bronze *around it*  
In the new grass of the field;  
And let him be drenched with the dew of heaven,  
And let <sup>[fn]</sup>him share with the beasts in the grass of the earth.

16 “Let his <sup>[fn]</sup>mind be changed from *that of a man*  
And let a beast’s <sup>[fn]</sup>mind be given to him,  
And let seven <sup>[fn]</sup>periods of time pass over him.

17 “This sentence is by the decree of the *angelic* watchers  
And the decision is a command of the holy ones,
