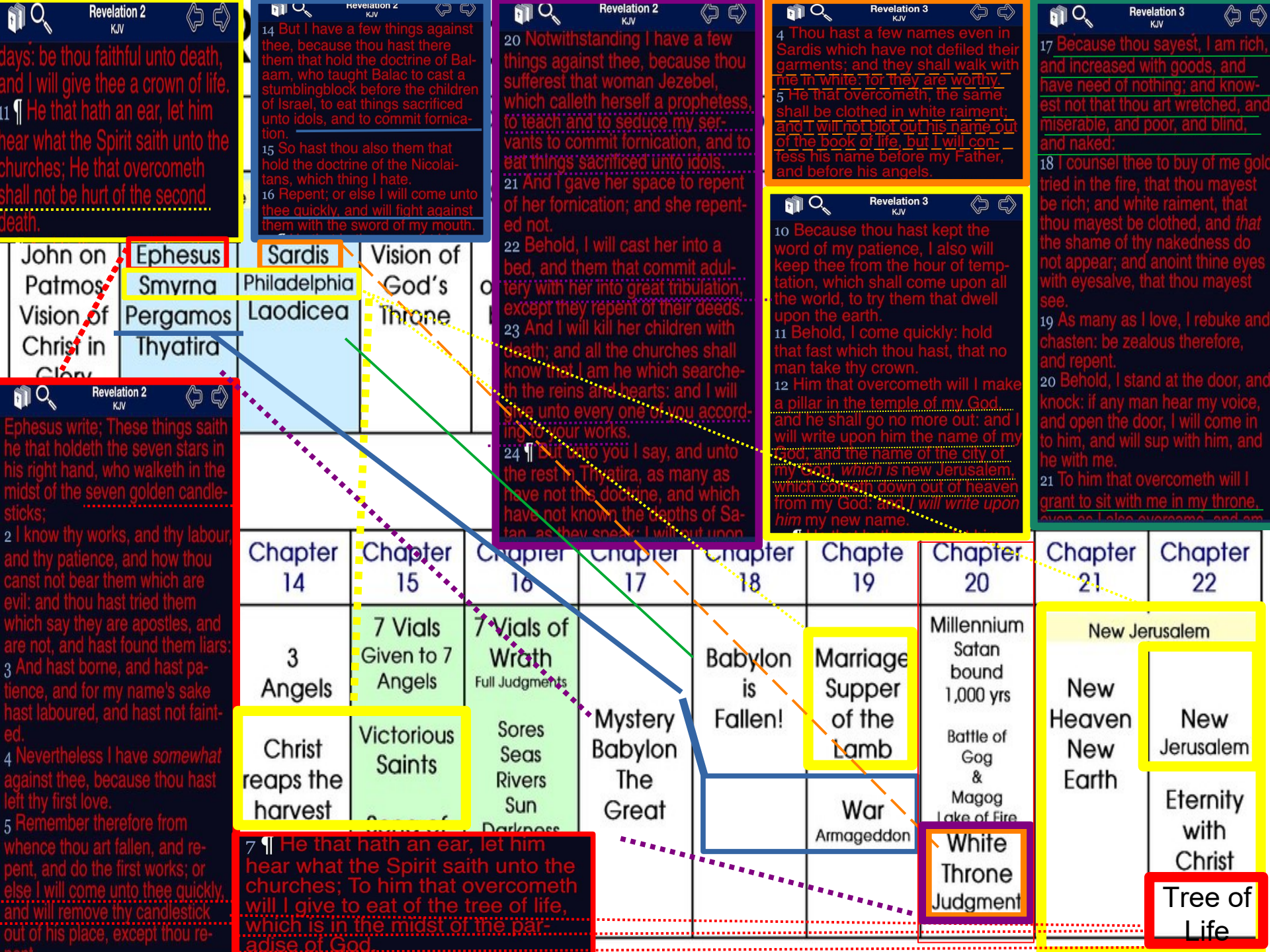

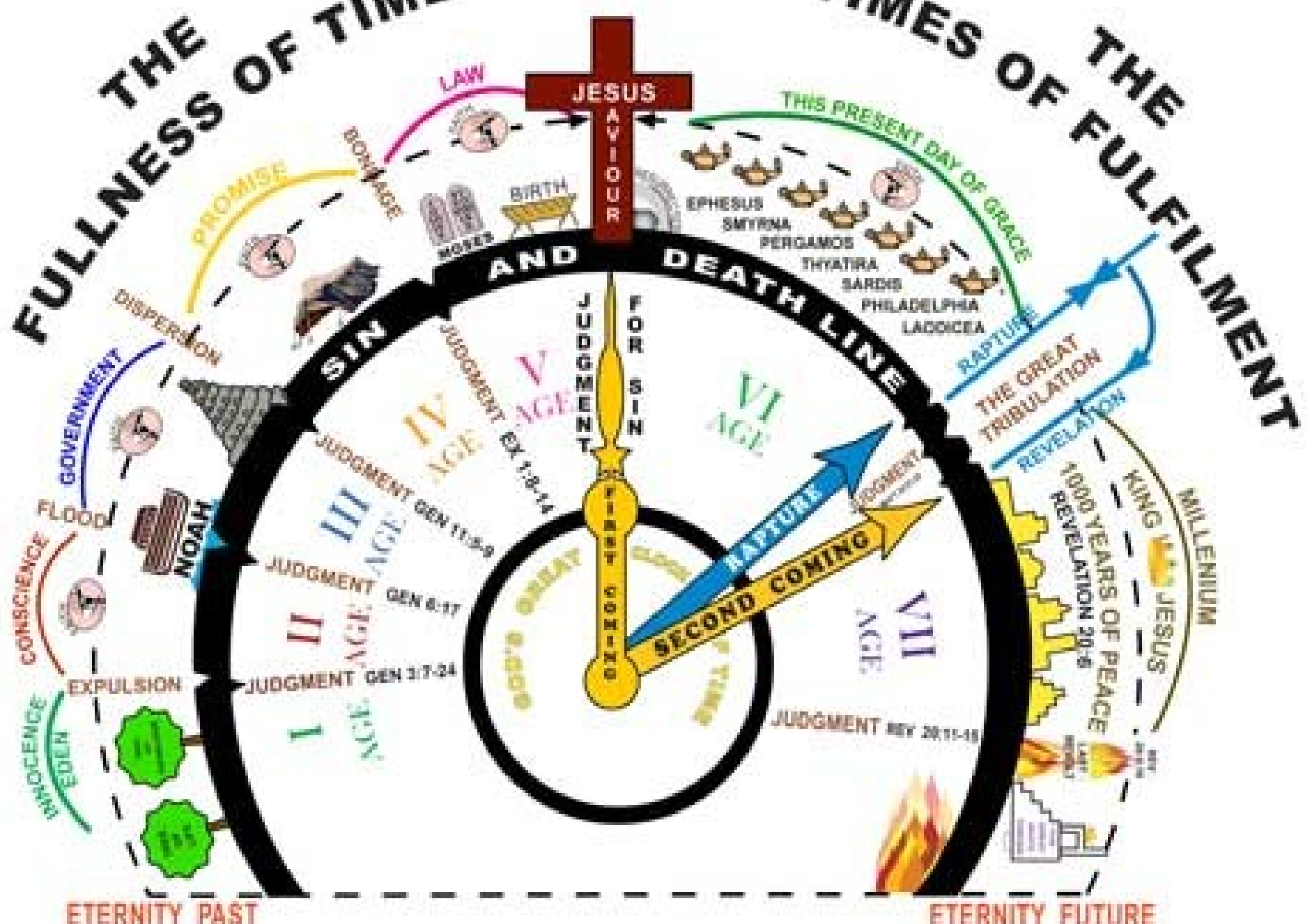

Revelation 20

The tribulation ends with the return of King Messiah, Jesus Christ. He returns with the armies of heaven including saints and angels.
Revelation 19:11-21

The survivors of the tribulation are gathered before the throne of Christ, to determine who enters the Millennium. Jerusalem is the capital of the world, from there Christ rules over the world as king of the Earth.
Matthew 25:31-46

The saved survivors of the earth repopulate the earth during the 1000-years. Death is rare and most people live for the entire 1000 years. Isaiah 65:20

The Saints, Old and New Testament rule and reign with Christ for 1000 years as the population of the earth increases. The Millennium saints, those who trust Christ, enter New Jerusalem. Rev. 21

The saints from the Old Testament, Church, Tribulation and Millennium enter eternity with Christ in the Heavenly Jerusalem.

Lake of Fire

The Antichrist and False prophet are cast into the Lake of Fire. Satan is bound 1000 years in the Abyss/ Hades.

Satan at the end of the Tribulation is released to tempt the population. Many fall to Satan test, and surround Jerusalem. They are immediately judged by Christ.
Revelation 20:7-9

Following the Millennium Rebellion, Christ evaporates the universe, and the Great White judgment takes place. Those in hell are resurrected to stand before Christ. Those whose names are not found in the Book of Life are cast in the Lake of Fire. Revelation 20:11-15



Revelation 20

¹ I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. ² He seized the dragon, the old serpent, which is the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole inhabited earth, and bound him for a thousand years, ³ and cast him into the abyss, and shut it, and sealed it over him, that he should deceive the nations no more, until

the thousand years were finished. After this, he must be freed for a short time. ⁴ I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded

for the testimony of Jesus, and for the word of God, and such as didn't worship the beast nor his image, and didn't receive the mark on their forehead and on their hand. They lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. ⁵ The rest of the dead didn't live until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. ⁶ Blessed and holy is

RESURRECTION. BLESSED AND HOLY IS
he who has part in the first
resurrection. Over these, the
second death has no power, but
they will be priests of God and of
Christ, and will reign with him one
thousand years.

⁷ And after the thousand years, Satan will be released from his prison, ⁸ and he will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to the war; the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. ⁹

They went up over the breadth of the earth, and surrounded the camp of the saints, and the beloved city. Fire came down out of heaven from God, and devoured them. ¹⁰

The devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet are also. They will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

¹¹ I saw a great white throne, and him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. There was found no place for them.

¹² I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and they opened books. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged

out of the things which were
written in the books, according to
their works. ¹³ The sea gave up the
dead who were in it. Death and
Hades ✕ gave up the dead who
were in them. They were judged,
each one according to his works. ¹⁴

Death and Hades ✕ were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. ¹⁵ If anyone was not found written in the book of life, he was cast into the lake of fire.

Bristlecone tree-ring chronologies can be extended thousands of years through the technique of cross-dating. Since tree rings vary in shape and structure — depending on climatic conditions extant when they were formed — a unique tree-ring pattern or "fingerprint" is produced over a period of years. By matching the inner tree-ring patterns of a living tree with the outer rings of even older dead stumps or logs, a cross-dated continuous sequence of annual rings can be established. As shown schematically, a living bristlecone, such as the **4,600-year-old Methuselah tree**, is actually only the first link in a tree-ring chronology which now extends **over 8,200 years**.
