





### Jewish burial customs [3]

- Same-day burial
- Wash body, anoint with spices, and wrap in a shroud
- Lay body in a bench/niche in a cave-tomb, with stone to seal, either square or round
- Seven days' public mourning at/in tomb
- One year later, bones collected and placed in a big clay pot or limestone ossuary; the bench can be used again

# Question: "What is the anointing? What does it mean to be anointed?"

**Answer:** The origin of anointing was from a practice of shepherds. Lice and other insects would often get into the wool of sheep, and when they got near the sheep's head, they could burrow into the sheep's ears and kill the sheep. So, ancient shepherds poured oil on the sheep's head. This made the wool slippery, making it impossible for insects to get near the sheep's ears because the insects would slide off. From this, anointing became symbolic of blessing, protection, and empowerment.

■ Psalm 41:9; Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me. Luke 22:3-4; <sup>3</sup> Then Satan entered Judas, surnamed Iscariot, who was numbered among the twelve. 4 So he went his way and conferred with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray Him to them. **John 13:18** 18 "I do not speak concerning all of you. Í know whom I have chosen; but that the Scripture may be fulfilled, 'He who eats bread with Me has lifted up his heel against Me.

### Jesus' Betrayal

"Even my close friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me." – Psalm 41:9, 900 B.C.

"Then the Lord said to me, 'Throw it to the potter, that magnificent price at which I was valued by them.' So I took the thirty shekels of silver and threw them to the potter in the house of the Lord." – Zechariah 11:13, 500 B.C.

"Then one of the twelve, named Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and said, 'What are you willing to give me to betray Him to you?' And they weighed out thirty pieces of silver to him." – Matthew 27:14-15

The Son of man indeed goeth, as it is written of him: but woe to that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! good were it for that man if he had never been born.





And saith unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful unto death: tarry ye here, and watch.





#### FIVE SECOND RULE!

#### Matthew 26:51, Cut Off His Ear

- Matthew 26:51 ...struck the slave of the high priest and cut off his ear.
- Luke 22:51 But Jesus answered and said, "Stop! No more of this." And He touched his ear and healed him.
- Jesus is still in control of the entire proceedings.
- Some think that Jesus healed him because otherwise Peter would have been charged with a capital crime and executed. This was attempted homicide, not a little cosmetic surgical operation.



Annas' Palace is recorded in Josephus' *War* 2.426 as having been burnt, together with the Palace of Agrippa and Bernice, in A.D. 70.



(<u>Matthew 26:75</u>) for <u>Peter</u> he got away with his life (<u>Saved his Skin</u>).

#### Judas made a Death Pact to Kill Jesus

& Money Deal (\$\$\$=Mammon)

"Then Entered Satan into Judas"
That led to Jesus Arrest/Trial/Execution:

"And the Chief Priests (Church) and Scribes sought How they might KILL him (Jesus); for they feared the people. Then Entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve. And he (Judas) went his way, and Communed with the Chief Priests (Church) and Captains (State), how he (Judas) might Betray him (Jesus) unto them."




