Traditional Area for the Baptism of Jesus

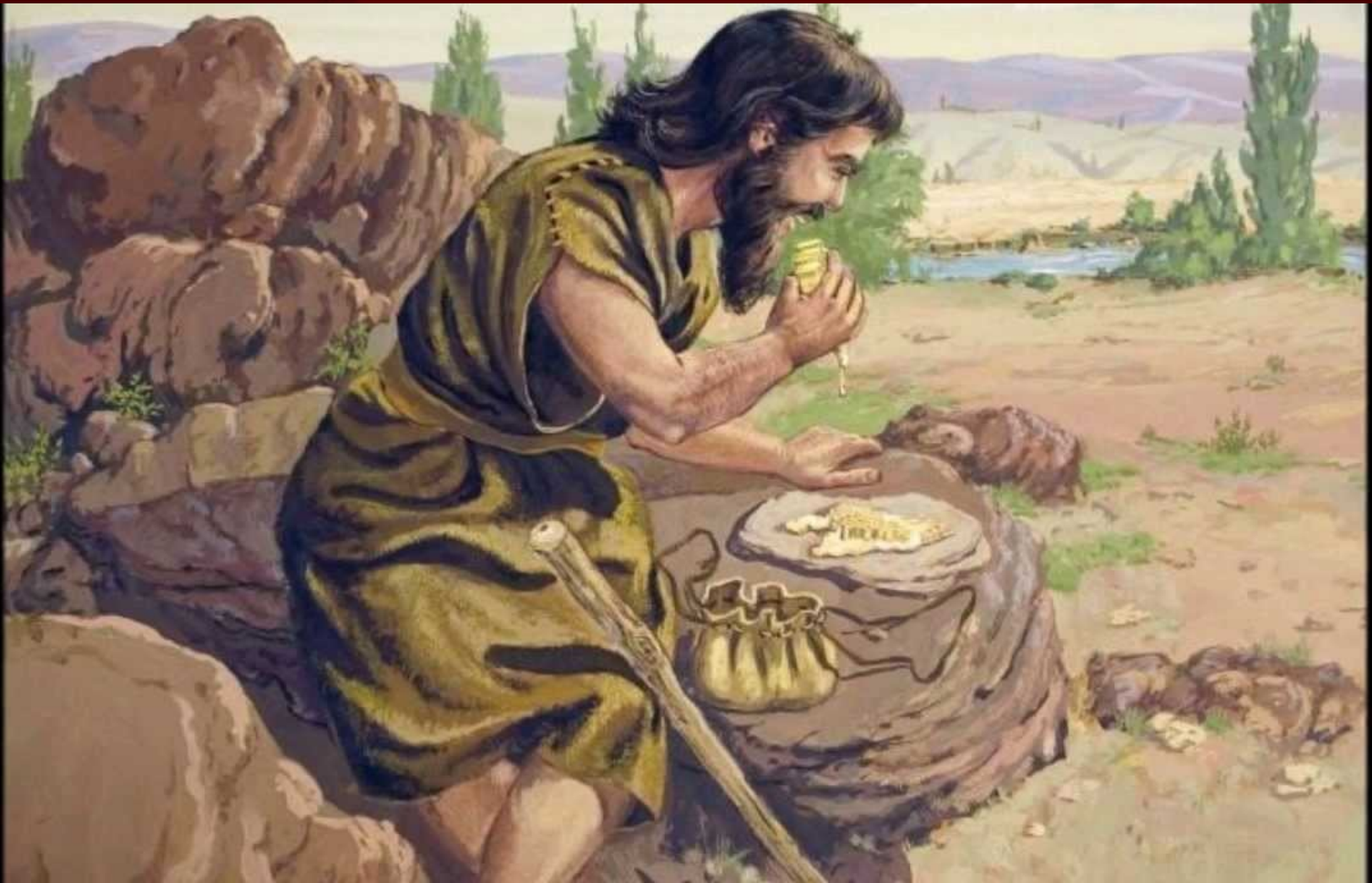

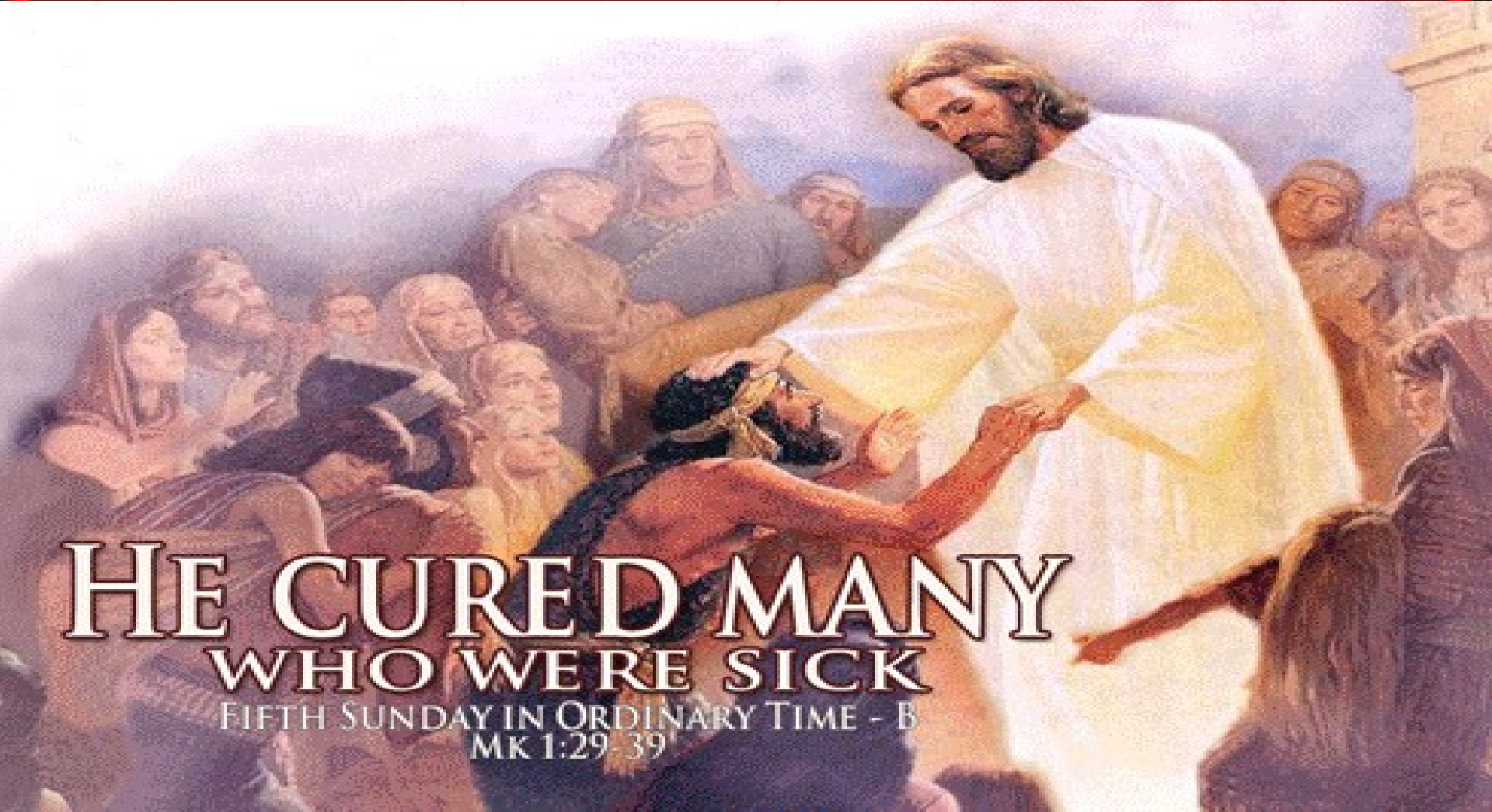
Friend of Jesus : Gift of Health
